Specimen Type: Urine

(Voided, Catheterized)

Patient Preparation: Have the patient void and discard 1st early morning

ırine.

Specimen Collection: Midstream, 2nd morning voided specimen is most

suitable for routine urinary cytology.

Note: Specimens collected on 3 consecutive days may provide more accurate results; however,

random specimens may also give satisfactory results

in symptomatic patients.

Submit specimen in a labeled cytology container.

Specimen Requirements: 50 mL to 100 mL preferred. Submit fresh or in

cytology fixative. 24 hour urine collections are NOT

acceptable due to degeneration.

Handling/Transport: If submitted fresh, submit to laboratory immediately,

refrigerate if delayed.
